Swim with turtles in Akumal





We will swim in Akumal, where you will have the opportunity to know the best place to dive with turtles in Mexico while you enjoy the warm Caribbean waters and white sand beaches.

Akumal means land of the turtles in Mayan.

Three species of turtles come to feed in the bay: the green turtle, the loggerhead turtle and the hawksbill turtle. You can swim on your own in the waters that are not protected but you are unlikely to see turtles in these waters, since it is not a feeding area. Going with a guide will help you allow us to see many more turtles and support the cooperatives that work to preserve the environment.



Cenote Carwash





We will visit and swim in the Carwash Cenote, it is a large open-air cenote free, almost like a pond, located on the highway between Tulum and Cobá. Officially called Cenote Aktun Ha, the nickname Cenote Carwash came from its unusual past!

The easily accessible Cenote Carwash is surrounded by lush green vegetation and a variety of wildlife within its waters. The Fish and turtles roam the underwater gardens and formations rocky and, sometimes, a small crocodile makes an appearance taking the sun on the shores of the cenote.

Cenote Carwash is relatively intact, although the addition of a swing rope and a jumping platform allow for a fun and dramatic to the cenote. Swimming and snorkeling are popular in the cenote and Its deep waters and large cave also attract divers.



Lagoon of the seven colors





Bacalar or Lagoon of the Seven Colors. Its name comes from the Mayan Bakhalal which means "near or surrounded by reeds." Circular in shape, the lagoon is shallow which allows for comfortable swimming. Around are found established both private houses and small inns that allow access to the lagoon.

This Magical Town of Quintana Roo is located next to a beautiful lagoon of seven shades of blue that offers the ideal space for diving, swimming and practice snorkeling.

Bacalar is also the gateway to the underwater caverns of the Cenote Azul and interesting Mayan archaeological zones covered by the jungle.



The Bacalar Rapids





The Bacalar rapids are a beautiful place just over 13 km south of the town of Bacalar.

This wonderful spa-restaurant is known as "Los Rápidos de Bacalar" because it is located right on the channel that divides the lagoon Bacalar with the Xul-Ha lagoon, this division and the constant flow of water between both lagoons it creates a strong current, in the purest style of a river, which can be quite strong depending on the season.

The facility has good facilities, clean bathrooms, a restaurant with good food and offers the rental service of kayaks and vests for the Enjoy water activities.



Mahahual





Mahahual is a small fishing village that comes to life when The cruise ships arrive at their port. It is considered a true cemetery marine, since its sea floor is home to more than 60 sunken ships, including Spanish and English galleons dating from the 16th and 17th centuries.

Its gentle waves make it a great place to swim and the reef is perfect for snorkeling, thanks to the colorful reefs and abundant marine life where You can see manta rays, turtles, eels and angel fish.

Explore its calm turquoise waters by kayak, or tour the pier in bike until you reach the lighthouse, which is a great spot for photos at sunrise.



Free time on the beach

Free time on the beach If you are looking for something to do, on the boardwalk you will find several of the beach clubs, restaurants and cafes in Mahahual.

One of Mahahual's specialties It is the Tikin Xik fish: a roasted fish with onion, annatto and other spices. It's a big dish to share with rice, beans, potatoes and fried plantains, plus salad.
